Independent Study Guidelines

BEDUC 392

Variable 1-5 credits; graded

Independent Study at the undergraduate or post-baccalaureate level in the UWB Education Program provides qualified students the opportunity to develop and conduct largely self-designed research projects in collaboration with Education faculty.

Independent Study does not exist as an alternative to the curriculum, but rather serves as a supplement to enable students the opportunity for a creative self-directed project. Independent Study is listed as BEDUC 392.

Guidelines for Independent Study

Prior to registration, the student must speak with a faculty member and obtain their willingness to sponsor the independent study.

The student will submit one copy of a typed, single page, double-spaced proposal to an Education faculty member for approval. The proposal should include: title, purpose of the proposed project, detailed outline of what the student is going to do, and a brief bibliography of appropriate sources.

The student should anticipate spending at least three hours per credit, per week on the project.
