Students should talk with faculty members in their major, their advisors and consult their degree webpages as they decide which of the courses listed above fit best with their academic training and life goals.

Because artifacts produced in these courses are ideal for inclusion in students' capstone portfolios, the IPR requirement should be satisfied prior to BIS 499. Many of the courses listed above have prerequisites, applications processes, priority registration for specific majors, or other requirements for enrollment.
