Social Security Number (SSN)

UW's Use of the SSN

At the UW, your SSN is used to match your admission test scores with your application and **to match your financial aid application with your admission application.** To avoid complications and a delay in financial aid notification, make sure your name and

SSN are identical on the financial aid and admission applications.

SSNs are not used for student identification; you will be assigned a UW student number once admitted.

Your SSN and other information from your application may be provided to educational research agencies for the purpose of conducting research and analysis related to Washington State higher education. Protecting the release of student information will be in accordance with all appropriate state and federal laws.
