Please **return enclosed coupons** with payments. Be sure to keep a record of your payments and due dates as we are **not** able to send out reminders.

Credit cards are not accepted with the Tuition Payment Plan – only checks and cash for the exact amounts detailed in this pamphlet. However, credit card payments are available on-line through the University of Washington, Seattle home page for those students who are **not** participating in the Tuition Payment Plan.

Payment Deadlines

- 1st Payment:** September 26, 2008
2nd Payment: October 10, 2008
3rd Payment: October 24, 2008

Payments must either be made:

- at the UWB Cashier by closing time on the due date, or in the Finance & Administration office UW1-271 by 5:00 p.m. on the due date.
- by mail, must be received by the due date.
Postmarks with the due date will not be accepted.
- in the after hours drop box in the Level 1 lobby of UW1 outside of Student Affairs **by 5:00 p.m. on the due date. No cash. Only checks accepted in the drop box.**

Payments made after the second and third due dates will be assessed a \$55.00 late fee for **each** late payment.

If your bank returns your payment as unpaid for any reason, you will be charged a fee of \$25.00 per returned item.

NOTE: If you are up-to-date on your Tuition Payment Plan, please ignore late payment statement notifications you receive via e-mail.
